



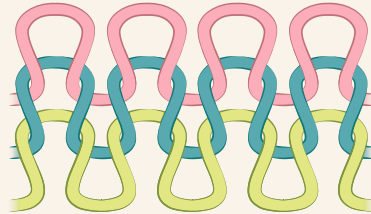

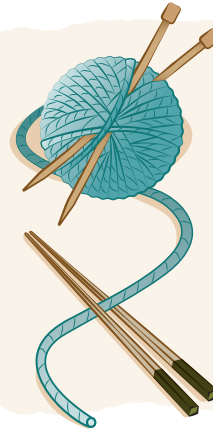
Hand Knitting

Getting Started

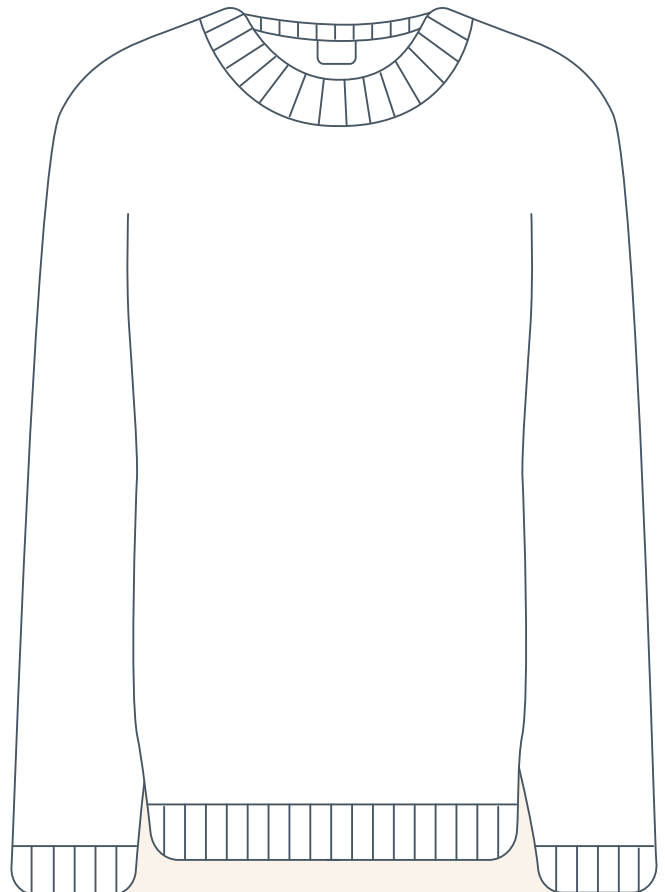
A little imagination, wool, and needles are all you need, or get creative using chopsticks or skewers, knitting with twine or ribbon for a truly original effect.



Design Challenge

Techniques or stitches are often associated with one region. Aran sweaters are knit in undyed cream wool, using stitches traditional to the Aran Islands, located off the west coast of Ireland.

Wool Care

Hand wash in cool water using a natural detergent. To avoid felting do not tumble-dry or over-agitate, dry flat.
