**Terms and Conditions:**

- We reserve the right to alter opening hours without notice. Opening hours are subject to change as there may be times we are closed due to adverse weather, essential maintenance and other matters beyond our control. We try to keep these closures to a minimum. Please check our website for the latest information on our opening hours, and we would encourage you to join our newsletter for updates.

We may not be able to offer any extensions on any Annual Passes if we do close.

- Correspondence with Pass Holders will be via e-mail and currently there can be one nominated email per annual pass account.
- If you opt in to emails for the e-newsletter, which will be sent via MailChimp, we'll send you regular emails for special events, Airfield news and discounts and occasional surveys. You can opt out at any time, however if you do opt out, note you may miss out on discounts and pass holder benefits. - You're welcome to visit the Estate as often as you like during opening times up until last admission which is an hour before closing. Current opening hours vary due to day light hours and can be found on our website [www.airfield.ie](http://www.airfield.ie)
- Annual Pass cards, benefits and discounts are non-transferrable.

If another unnamed person is found with your access card availing of benefits or accessing the estate in your place your card and account may be frozen and/or terminated at the discretion of Airfield Estate.

- We're required to take a picture of the main named pass holders (adult) associated to your Annual Pass and this will be printed onto your card.
- If you need a replacement card, we can issue at the cost of €10 per card.
- Children under 16 years should always be accompanied and supervised by an adult on the Estate. • Car parking at Airfield is limited and is offered on a first-come, first-served basis. It is not guaranteed with your Annual Pass.
- Areas open around the estate are subject to change as required for operational, health and safety, financial and environmental sustainability matters. It may not be possible to give advance notice of closures and there will be no refunds or other compensation issued due to areas being closed.
- An Annual Pass cannot be used in conjunction with any other promotion.
- Airfield Estate reserves the right to change benefits and terms at any time without notice.
- Airfield Estate reserves the right to cancel an annual pass at any time.
- Information will be collected in accordance with Data Privacy Rules.
- Unfortunately, non-compliant visitors leave us with no option other than request you leave the estate in the interest of public health and safety. Please understand that this for your safety as much as our staff and other guests

**Nominated Adults** (not applicable to Individual, 1 Person, 2 Senior or 2 Person Pass accounts)

- Group Passes (i.e. 3 Person Pass and upwards) can nominate one named adult on the pass who can visit in place of the pass holders and not in addition too, known as the nominated adult.
- The nominated adult is an additional benefit to the account to allow for a child minder or friend to visit the estate in place of the named card holders.

- It is your responsibility as a pass holder to inform the nominated adult of the T&Cs as in using the account they are also bound by them.
- The nominated adult is not a pass holder, they are a benefit of the annual pass account.
- The nominated adult will not be issued with a card, they can gain free entry in place of the named adults on the pass. For the nominated adult to gain entry they must present themselves at the Ticket Kiosk.
- The nominated adult may not bring adult guests into the estate on the pass, they can visit on their own or with children the pass would normally cover.
- Nominated adults are not permitted to use the pass holder's cards. If they are found with the cards they may be confiscated by the ticket desk staff.
- Annual Pass benefits only apply to the named pass holders not the nominated adults or guests.

What does your annual pass cover on any given day?

- 1 Person Pass: Allows access for 1 named Pass holder.
- 2 Senior Person Pass: Allows access for 2 named Pass holders OR 1 named pass holder and 1 guest.
- 2 Person Pass: Allows access for 2 named Pass holders OR 1 named pass holder and 1 guest.
- 3 Person Pass: Allows access for 2 named Pass holders & 1 guest OR 1 named pass holder and 2 guests OR 1 named nominated adult and up to 2 children.
- 4 Person Pass: Allows access for 2 named Pass holders & 2 guests OR 1 named pass holder and 3 guests OR 1 named nominated adult and up to 3 children
- 5 Person Pass: Allows access for 2 named Pass holders & 3 guest OR 1 named pass holder and 4 guests OR 1 named nominated adult and up to 4 children
- 6 Person Pass: Allows access for 2 named Pass holders & 4 guests OR 1 named pass holder and 5 guests OR 1 named nominated adult and up to 5 children

NOTE: A person or guest is an adult or child over the age of 4 yrs. Children aged 3 years and under are free.

**NOTE: COVID-19**
